GUIDELINES FOR MEETING IN-PERSON

We want to be clear: our desire to meet together does not outweigh our desire to protect the most vulnerable in our communities. Because of this, it is important to know that we will be modifying our environments and services to reflect both of these values. For the safety and protection of you and your family, any COF staff member who displays COVID symptoms, or has a family member with symptoms, will be required to self-quarantine and will not be permitted on the COF campus for 14 days. We ask you to please take the same precaution when considering joining COF for live worship in the weeks ahead.

What to expect if you plan to join us:

- Masks are strongly encouraged. We recognize there are a lot of opinions regarding this topic. However, the counsel we have received from multiple physicians is that wearing a mask is one way we can help protect others, especially from those who may be asymptomatic carriers. All staff and volunteers will be wearing masks, so you won't be alone if you wear one!
- We will have hand sanitizing stations throughout the campus.
- Seating in the Worship Room will be adjusted to accommodate social distancing between families.
- We will clean high-traffic areas, including restroom facilities, between services.
- We will receive our regular offering by way of boxes/baskets on campus, but we also encourage giving online at [Cof.church](#) or the COF Houston App.

COF KIDS, STUDENTS & SPECIAL NEEDS

In all family areas, students will experience a safe and fun experience! Everyone who enters the students, kids or special needs areas will be temperature checked. Areas will be continually cleaned and sanitized, and all leaders will be wearing face coverings. Please note some updates to room locations. Special Needs and COF Students have moved to the portable buildings. All birth-5th grade will meet in the preschool wing.

IMMUNOCOMPROMISED ROOM

If you are immunocompromised, in a high-risk category, or want to be extra cautious, join our Watch Party on September 13 at the church, at 9:30am, in a separated environment from the general public. Masks will be required (for children & adults) with strict social distancing and sanitizing precautions in place.
